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# **UNCONTESTED DIVORCE WORKBOOK**

## **Getting Started**

An uncontested divorce (called a Joint Petition) is an agreement between you and your spouse on how to divide property, assets, debts, and spousal support. Uncontested divorces can even include custody schedule and child support. An uncontested divorce is the easiest, quickest and least expensive way to get a divorce.

Right Lawyers will help you finalize the terms of your uncontested divorce, draft all the documents needed, coordinate both spouse's signatures, and file the final documents with the court. ## **What if We Cannot Agree?**

After each item, choose "H" for husband or "W" for wife, to show who will be retaining the item. You can split items equally by choosing "H" and "W". Add any notes to provide special details.

You and your spouse may not agree on certain issues. Or you may not know what to agree to. For example, you may not know how much child support to pay. Or, you may not know what custody plan to choose. This is fine. Complete the worksheet as best as you can, and our attorneys will guide you through those unknown areas.

**CHILD CUSTODY SCHEDULE** - Nevada prefers both parents to have joint physical custody, unless one parent having primary physical custody is in the best interests of the children. Joint custody is having a minimum of 146 days of custody a year. The most common joint custody schedules are having the children 4 days one week and 3 days the next week. Some parents prefer five days one week and two days the next. Week on and week off schedules are becoming more common for older children.
